Gospel Reflection

The prayer of the blind man, Bartimaeus, is a model of petition in its reverence, simplicity, perseverance and trust. There is reverence in the way Jesus is addressed with a messianic title, Son of David. His prayer is as simple as could be, with no unnecessary words or complicated explanations. He shows perseverance in the way he shouted all the louder when people tried to stop him. The inner voices that tend to stop our prayer are feelings of unworthiness, doubts and guilt. The blindness of Bartimaeus reminds us that faith is only dim light. Bartimaeus was a beggar and we are all beggars before God
