If anyone requires transport to attend the Service, please contact the Parish Office.

HOUSE BLESSING: I would like to visit your homes and bless them. House blessing is a normal service in Christian tradition, especially after Easter. It includes a short time of prayer led by the Priest, who blesses the house with holy water. It also helps you and the Priest to get to know each other better.
