FOODBANK: There has been a reduction in donations to the Foodbank recently. Please continue to make donations, as the need is very great. At the moment, items which are urgently needed are toiletries such as **deodorant, shampoo, shaving foam, adult toothbrushes and soap / shower gel**. Urgently needed food items are **long-life fruit juice, instant mashed potato, sponge puddings and pasta sauce**. Please note they have a 12 month supply of PASTA. It is NOT NEEDED.
