Please note they have a 12 month supply of PASTA. It is NOT NEEDED

Toiletries & Basic Items

<u>Urgent</u>: washing up liquid, deodorant, shampoo, shaving foam/gel, toothpaste, size 5 nappies

<u>Always required</u>: toilet rolls, toothpaste, toothbrushes, strong carrier bags
