SYNOD ON SYNODALITY: On the conclusion of the first session of the Synod of Bishops on synodality, Pope Francis said in his homily during Mass at St. Peter's Basilica on 29 October:

"We may have plenty of good ideas on how to reform the church, but let's remember: to adore God and to love our brothers and sisters with his love, that is the great and perennial reform."

The synod on synodality marked the first-time laypeople and women religious, could take part as voting members. Of the total 364 members, close to 25% were "non-bishop members" and 54 were women.
