Those Parishioners who used envelopes are kindly asked, in the future, to place their loose Offertory directly in the collection at weekend Masses. Since we encouraged Parishioners to move from using Gift Aid Envelopes to making their Offertory donations via Standing Order, only a relatively small number of Parishioners remain using Gift Aid Envelopes. There is a high cost associated with ordering the small number of sets of specially numbered and dated envelopes. Also, for some years, we have been claiming back gift aid from HMRC from all the loose cash placed in the Offertory. Food Urgent: long life fruit juice, tinned fruit, tinned tuna, tinned vegetables, long life custard, cooking sauces, coffee, tinned spaghetti, long-life milk, instant mash, soup, long-life rice pudding

Always required: tea, long life sponge puddings, tinned tomatoes, tinned meat

Please note they have a 12 month supply of PASTA. It is NOT NEEDED

Toiletries & Basic Items Urgent: washing up liquid, shampoo, deodorant, shaving foam/gel, toothpaste, child toothbrushes, nappies size 6+, 7 & 8

Always required: soap, toilet rolls, strong carrier bags
