IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT ISSUES WITH DIOCESAN EMAIL SYSTEM

If you are reading this Newsletter in Church, and you have not received your usual copy of the Newsletter by email, I wish to make you aware that there are serious problems with the Diocese's email system, which is currently not fit for purpose. I was informed 5 weeks ago that the weekly Newsletter had to be issued from the Diocesan domain email address. Since the move to using the Diocesan email domain @northamptondiocese.org there have been an increasing number of emails each week which have not been delivered. They have been classed as spam by the Parishioners' email service provider. Most of the failed deliveries are with those who have @btinternet.com email addresses. I have individually emailed each person concerned (approximately 20% of those on our distribution list) and asked them to send a reply to me and to **save the Diocesan email address in their list of "Contacts"**. 60% of this number replied to me. Those who did not reply may be away at the moment or they may *not* be using email regularly and checking their email box. Of those who did reply, I tried to send them the Newsletter to establish the connection. Not all received the copy first time and some did not receive the Newsletter after 4 attempts to send it. (My apologies to those who emailed me and who think I have not replied. I have tried to send an email to you, however I still can't get an email through to you). I realise this is a *pain* for those Parishioners who wish to receive their Newsletter and urgent information from the Parish by email. If in sending out the Newsletter this weekend, I find there are a large number of non-delivery reports because it is thought the email is "*spam*" I will attempt to send the email from our dedicated Parish domain email address once again (@staugustines.org.uk).
