THE MONTH OF JULY is a month dedicated to the Precious Blood. It was formally instituted by Pope Pius IX in 1849, but the devotion dates back to the scriptures themselves. Do you remember the passage in the Gospel of John where Jesus' side is pierced by a lance? The early Christian Fathers saw this as the moment of the birth of the Church as from his side flowed blood and water, the beginnings of the sacramental life of the Church. One of the ways we can honour the Precious Blood of Jesus is through receiving it from the chalice during Mass. The General Instruction in the Roman Missal reminds us that Holy Communion has a fuller form as a sign when it is received under both kinds – the Body and Blood. It makes the sign of the eucharistic banquet 'more clearly evident'.

Boxes for donations can be found in each Church. The items on their Shopping List are: **Food Urgent:** long life fruit juice, tinned fruit, tinned tuna, tinned vegetables, long life custard, cooking sauces, coffee, tinned spaghetti, long-life milk, instant mash, soup, long-life rice pudding.

Always required: tea, long life sponge puddings, tinned tomatoes, tinned meat.

Please note they have a 12 month supply of PASTA. It is NOT NEEDED.

Toiletries & Basic Items Urgent: washing up liquid, shampoo, deodorant, shaving foam/gel, toothpaste, child toothbrushes, nappies size 6+, 7 & 8.

Always required: soap, toilet rolls, strong carrier bags.
